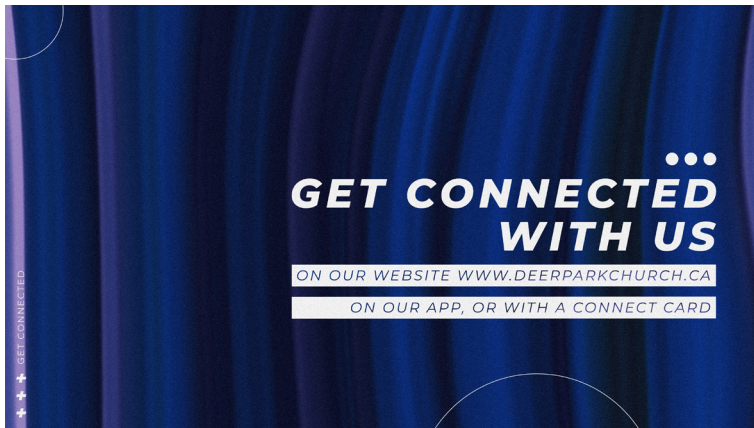

While our nursery is still closed, there is a baby changing table in the Cafe, or in the accessible washrooms in the foyer.



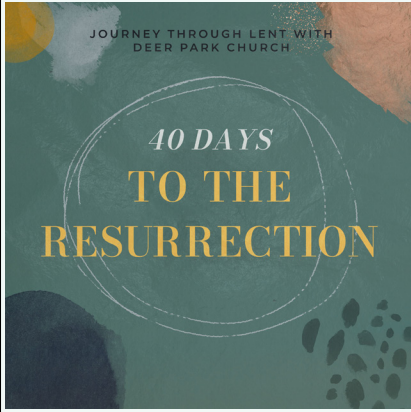

## Relief in Lebanon: Global Emergency Relief Fund

On August 4, 2020, 200 people were killed, 7000 people injured, and 300,000 people made homeless in the explosion in Beirut, Lebanon. During the month of February we are collecting funds to send to Beirut to pay for the repair of 50 houses through an Alliance church. One house will cost approximately \$372 to repair, bringing the total cost for 50 houses to \$18,600. As a family, please consider giving above and beyond your regular giving to bless the families in Lebanon. We may feel as though we can't do much in these days, but we can make a difference overseas.
