UKRAINE HUMANITARIAN AND REFUGEE SUPPORT

The humanitarian aid wing of the Alliance Church has been meeting practical needs through our workers in Poland and Ukraine since the outbreak of the present crisis. Including the fundraiser featuring Potter's Clay, our church has thus far contributed close to \$8500 to the relief effort, right on the ground. If anyone would like to give, please just mark your offering for "Ukraine" and it will be forwarded directly to CAMA Services in Poland through the Alliance National Office.

Deer Park is also participating on the Red Deer Committee to be prepared as a city for the possible arrival of refugees to our city.
