

### **FAMILY NEWS:**

As a church, we have been blessed for many years to have Don Tjart and his family as a part of our staff team. Over the past several months, our church Elder Board has been reviewing the direction of our church's overall financial health, looking back over the past several years as well as projecting into the future. As a result of those discussions, the Board has made the difficult decision to reduce the size of our pastoral staff by no longer employing a full-time worship and communications pastor, which means that Don's tenure at our church will come to a close at the end of December.

We are abundantly thankful for Don and Dolores as friends and co-workers in God's family and for their faithful service during their time here at Deer Park Church. Please continue to be in prayer for Don and Dolores as they listen for God's voice and plan for the next season.

### ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

OCTOBER 24, 6PM, SANCTUARY

Our Deer Park Church AGM will be held on October 24, 2021, beginning at 6:00 pm. Our agenda will include elder and nominating committee elections (please see below for bios of our two elder candidates), the passing of the budget, as well as one recommendation from the nominating committee for the 2021-22 year. Our Elder Board has approved the following small adjustments for this year only:

1) Our AGM will be held in the church sanctuary, but will also be available to stream online. Our printed AGM report will be available beginning Sunday, October 10, and will be posted online the same day at *deerparkchurch.ca/agm*. Typically we open our AGM to everyone, and we continue to be glad to share this evening with all members and adherents; however, for this year only, we ask that interested non-members would follow the AGM online.

2) We will be hosting a Zoom pre-AGM Town Hall on October 17th, at 6:30pm, especially for those who have more detailed questions about the budget, or who have other questions or discussion items but aren't able to attend the in-person AGM. Please email office@deerparkchurch.ca to receive the link.

3) The board has approved 'advance voting' for this year's AGM to accommodate members who prefer not to attend in person. Ballots will be available at the church office from October 18-22 from 8:30am-3:30pm, and will include a vote on elder and nominating committee candidates, as well as a vote on budget approval. The board has approved a temporary provision for this year only that members voting in advance will count toward our quorum attendance number.

Thank you to everyone who has been contributing to this process, especially our elders and staff, along with our nominating committee. And thank you again to the church family for your flexibility in accommodating this season with a few small adjustments. God bless you my friends.
